Programme to get students hooked on the Internet



THE CYBER COACH WAY

The coach donated by the DRB-Hicom group is fitted with 20 computers hooked up to the Internet through the school's only telephone line.

A United Nations Development Programme project in collaboration with Mimos Bhd, it will initiate the 400 eager pupils and 25 teachers of the school into the cyberworld.

The bus will stop at 20 rural schools in Selangor to provide training for teachers and students on Information Communication Technology.

Malaysia was chosen for the pilot project under UNDP's Asia Pacific Development Information Programme that would be expanded to other developing countries.
